Plant and crop seeds, a genuine treasure of humankind, are the living guardians of the history and genetic heritage of cultivated plant species. In connection with food sovereignty, the economic independence of farming communities and biodiversity conservation, for several years now the seed sector has been a core strategic issue.

It is facing the uniformization of crops as well as the industrial standardization that are causing a decrease in genetic diversity, thus undermining the autonomy of farms, and consequently, our planet's biodiversity.

Faced with the erosion of this agricultural biodiversity and the loss of autonomy in terms of crop seeds, women, as custodians of life, are on the front lines in fighting the loss of knowledge and skills linked to seed reproduction and conservation.

On an everyday basis, in France or on the other side of the world, women contribute to enhanced knowledge of seeds and their vital importance for preservation of the planet's nourishing heritage and biodiversity.

The call for applications is open to women from all over the world, from 15 September to 15 November 2020
