FOCUS ON THE 2022 WINNER ALAIN SCHROEDER

Winner 2022, Alain Schroeder testifies to the issues surrounding a majestic species: the Sumatran orangutan. Threatened for many reasons, the monkeys are forced to leave their natural habitat. Alain interfered in the daily life of those who fight for the survival of this species, from clinics and quarantine centers, to the place where the wild has all the place it deserves: the tropical forest.

Alain Schroeder was born in Belgium in 1955. He has been working as a photojournalist for several decades, producing images that have appeared in more than 500 magazines. These subjects are varied: ecology, art, culture, travel. He tells his stories in fifteen photos, trying to "capture the essence of a moment through light and framing". Holder of numerous prizes, he also co-founded, in 1989, the Belgian photo agency Reporter.
